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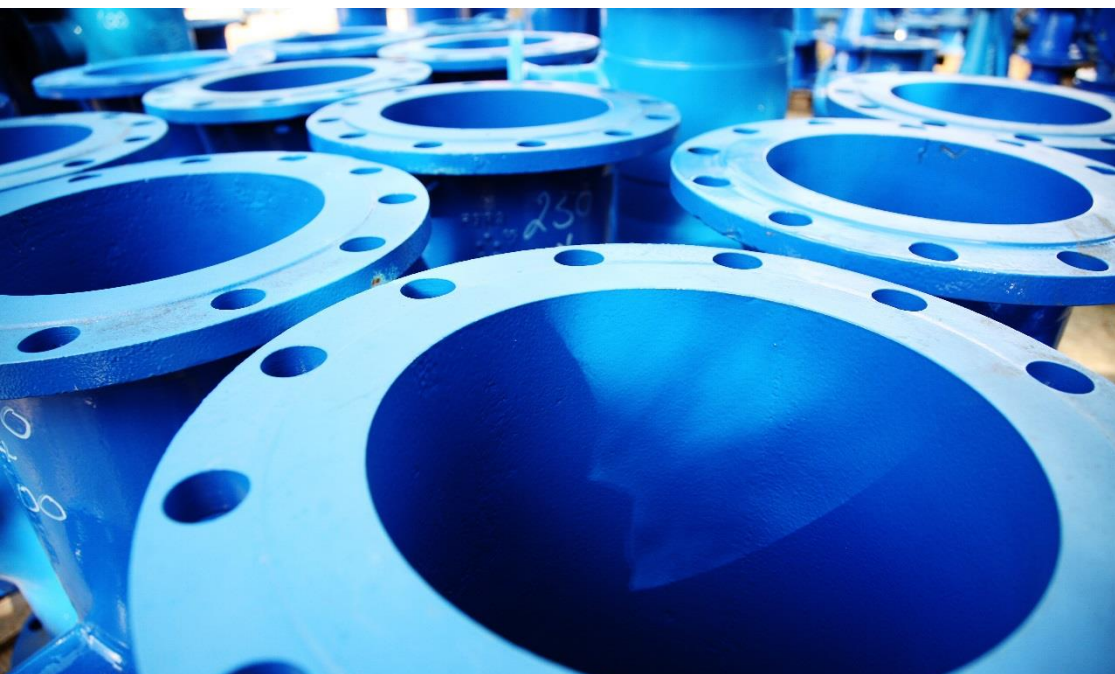

- d. South East Water must be informed of any proposed modifications to the plumbing or installations after the water supply has been connected.
- e. I/We will notify South East Water in writing, as soon as possible of the plot to postal address, the occupiers name, date of occupation and meter reading.

I/We enclose;

- A DWG for the site
- A soils report- if not provided the quotation will be produced based on an appropriate barrier pipe being installed.
- An internal water services plan (required under Regulation 5 of the Water Supply (Water Fittings) Regulations 1999.

I have filled in all the relevant sections of this form and the fittings table. The details I have given within this application are accurate.

I/We accept that any legal permissions to undertake work on land not in my/our ownership must be obtained by me/us before work can be carried out. It is my/our responsibility to ensure that all legal matters are agreed and in the event of any dispute South East
