4. 'Communal or Commercial appliance' means an (including a dishwasher, a washing machine, and a waste disposal unit) elsewhere than in a house.
5. In any calculation a minimum of 6 loading units shall be included in respect of each house for domestic appliances. Unless there is no outlet for a dishwasher or washing machine.

## 6. Checklist and declaration

I/we understand that;

- a. All plumbing work and installations must comply with the Water Supply (Water Fittings) Regulations 1999
- b. I confirm that I will only be installing approved products on the plumbing systems.
- c. Payment for the service will be required in advance, the private supply pipe must be laid and inspected in open excavation before the new connection is completed.
- d. South East Water must be informed of any proposed modifications to the plumbing or installations after the water supply has been connected.
- e. I/We will notify South East Water in writing, as soon as possible of the plot to postal address, the occupiers name, date of occupation and meter reading.

I/We enclose;

- A site plan- referencing the roads in the area and marked to show preferred connection point
- A soils report- if required
- An internal water services plan (required under Regulation 5 of the Water Supply (Water Fittings) Regulations 1999.

I have filled in all the relevant sections of this form and the fittings table. The details I have given within this application are accurate. I/We accept that any legal permissions to undertake work on land not in my/our ownership must be obtained by me/us before work

can be carried out. It is my/our responsibility to ensure that all legal matters are agreed and in the event of any dispute South East Water will reserve the right to charge me/us for additional costs that may arise.

I/We accept that it may be necessary to consult a solicitor if I/We are unsure of the position.
